Travel East on Sky Harbor Blvd. Turn right toward Terminal 2/3/West Exit/24th Street/Downtown Phoenix/Rental Car Return. Turn right onto E. Sky Harbor Blvd. Stay straight to go onto I-10 W. Take Exit 148 toward Jefferson St./Washington Street. Turn left onto W. Washington Street. It is on the right.

Southbound I-17 from Flagstaff

I-17 S Merge onto the I-10 via Exit 200A toward Central Phoenix. Take the 7th Ave exit, Exit 144A. Keep right to take the 7th Ave South ramp. Turn right onto N 7th Ave. Turn left onto W Adams St. Turn right onto 4th Ave. Take the 1st right onto W. Washington Street. It is on the right.

Westbound I-10 from Tucson

Take Exit 150A toward I-10 TRUCK W/Flagstaff. Take Exit 195B toward Rental Car/7th St/Central Ave. Turn left onto E. Maricopa Fwy. Turn right onto S 7th St. Turn left onto W Washington Street. It is on the right.

Dr. Kurt Bumby, Ph.D.

Dr. Kurt Bumby is the current President of ATSA. He received his doctoral degree from the Clinical Psychology Training Program's forensic specialty track at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Dr. Bumby serves on the National Advisory Committee for the Safer Society Foundation. Over the past several years, he has had a diverse career in the juvenile justice and adult criminal justice fields, primarily specializing in the area of sex offender management. He currently is a Senior Manager with The Center for Effective Public Policy, a criminal justice consulting firm that administers, among a number of national initiatives, the Center for Sex Offender Management (CSOM). At the Center, Dr. Bumby provides training and technical assistance to a range of stakeholders—including legislative committees, the judiciary, supervision and treatment agencies, paroling authorities, and other multidisciplinary groups throughout the country—and is involved in the development of policy and practice briefs, training curricula, and other written resources and products. Dr. Bumby has published journal articles and book chapters on a variety of forensic topics such as the assessment, treatment, and overall management of sex offenders, youth violence, child maltreatment, reentry, and alternative sentencing options for adults and juveniles. He is a prior recipient of the ATSA Graduate Research Award for Research Excellence in the Field of Sex Offender Treatment and a co-recipient of the Hugo G. Beigel Research Award from the Society for the Scientific Study of Sexuality.

Robin J. Wilson, Ph.D., ABPP is a researcher, educator, and board certified clinical psychologist who has worked with sexual and other offenders in hospital, correctional and private practice settings for more than 25 years. He maintains an international practice in consulting and clinical psychology and is an Assistant Clinical Professor (Adjunct) of Psychiatry and Behavioral Neuroscience at McMaster University. Dr. Wilson's interests are focused on collaborative models of risk management and restoration in community settings. He has published and presented widely on the diagnosis and treatment of social and sexual psychopathology. Dr. Wilson is the President of the Florida Association for the Treatment of Sexual Abusers and is the elected Southern Regional Representative on the Board of the Association for the Treatment of Sexual Abusers (ATSA). Dr. Wilson is presently the Editor of the ATSA Forum and sajrt.blogspot.com, in addition to being a member of the editorial boards of several scientific journals.
