## WHO'S PRESENTING?



**John H. White, Ph.D.** began his career in the Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) before continuing his law enforcement endeavors as an investigator sergeant for the Dallas, Texas Police Department, where he worked in patrol, the Psychological Services Office, Internal Affairs Division, and the Fugitive and Special Investigations Division. After receiving a Ph.D. from the University of North Texas, Dr. White began teaching at Stockton University where he developed forensic psychology tracks for the criminal justice and psychology programs. He is a licensed forensic and neuropsychologist in New Jersey where he specializes in the evaluation and treatment of both adult and juvenile sex offenders. He also conducts competency tests and insanity evaluations for those standing trial and he conducts neuropsychological evaluations of children and adolescents who are experiencing problems in school and with their families. He has been inducted into the Vidocq Society in Philadelphia, an organization that meets once per month to discuss cold case homicides. He is the Director of Psychology at HealthSouth Rehabilitation Hospital of Vineland where he conducts psychological and neuropsychological assessments of patients. He is an unpaid consultant/presenter to the technical advisors and writers of the TV show *Criminal Minds* and to the originators of the show, *Killer Profile* on the Biography Channel. He earned a Clinical Neuropsychology Certificate from Fielding University in New York City.



**Dominique Roe-Sepowitz, MSW, Ph.D.** is an associate professor of Social Work at Arizona State University. She received her MSW from the Tucson ASU campus and her Ph.D. from Florida State University. Dominique has extensive clinical experience working with sexually abused children and adults and has been trained on trauma reduction techniques including EMDR. Dominique has worked as a private practitioner as well as provided a psychoeducation group to women in many settings (prisons, residential programs, women's resource center and diversion program). Dominique is currently providing the group (named Esuba) at the Prostitution Diversion Program and supervising an Esuba group at a residential treatment program for adolescent girls who have been sexually exploited. Dominique has published numerous articles about mental health and delinquency, prostitution and exiting challenges, and the mental health needs of women and youth in the correctional system. She has presented nationally at Social Work and Criminology conferences as well as the Toledo Conference on Prostitution and Sex Trafficking. Dominique is a original board member of the National Research Consortium on Commercial Sexual Exploitation. Dominique enjoys mentoring students and has a number of apprentice opportunities for clinical experience as well for research assistantships. She has recently worked with a number of local city and social service agencies to provide an arrest-alternative entitled Project ROSE (Reaching Out to the Sexually Exploited).

### **From Sky Harbor Airport**

Travel East on Sky Harbor Blvd. Turn right toward Terminal 2/3/West Exit/24<sup>th</sup> Street/Downtown Phoenix/Rental Car Return. Turn right onto E. Sky Harbor Blvd. Stay straight to go onto I-10 W. Take Exit 148 toward Jefferson St. /Washington Street. Turn left onto W. Washington Street. It is on the right.

### **Southbound I-17 from Flagstaff**

I-17 S Merge onto the I-10 via Exit 200A toward Central Phoenix. Take the 7<sup>th</sup> Ave exit, Exit 144A. Keep right to take the 7<sup>th</sup> Ave South ramp. Turn right onto N 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. Turn left onto W Adams St. Turn right onto 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. Take the 1<sup>st</sup> right onto W. Washington Street. It is on the right.
